Our Vision & Purpose

IEHLC is a regional non-partisan 501 (c) 3 organization comprising of community leaders who have come together and collaborated in order to improve the quality of life for the Hispanic community in the Inland Empire. The Council has centered its work in business, education and public policy.

The Council meets regularly to conduct an open dialogue in order to find solutions for any compromising issues within the region. It is our vision to improve quality of life, create opportunities in order to sustain positive and responsible growth in the Hispanic community.

IEHLC Members include regional key business and community leaders, but are not limited to local government, businesses, media, universities, healthcare organizations, and non-profit organizations. Open Meetings

Executive Board Meetings

- Only board members or designated alternates may attend to discuss IEHLC business.
- The Board consists of officers, designated members-at-large and committee chairs.
- Meetings are quarterly.

Membership Benefits

- a. Educate legislators, other public servants, and the general public as a whole regarding issues of importance to the Hispanic community, such as education, healthcare, infrastructure, government, security, economy and business
- b. Provide educational resources to assist the Hispanic Community in the Inland Empire
- c. Educate Hispanic voters in the use and benefits of the political system, while remaining non-partisan
- d. Carry on other charitable and educational activities associated with these goals as allowed by law
